

Music Teacher Mentoring

A colleague to colleague professional relationship.

* What is a 'Music Teacher Mentor' ?

A Music Teacher Mentor is a music teacher with experience who mentors/supports another teacher.

* What do they offer me ?

The mentoree gets to define the parameters of the teaching arrangement. They have a specific goal which the mentor agrees to help them achieve.

For example, some mentorees might want specific help with matters relating to exam preparation, technical development advice or help in furthering their own playing.

* How often do I see them ?

As often as agreed. Can be ad hoc or regular sessions.

* How much does it cost ?

Mentors set their own fees usually in accordance with their standard teaching fee.

* Who are they ?

Mentors on the MTAQ website have been vetted and their biographies are there for further information.

* How do I proceed from here if I am interested ?

You can contact the mentor directly via their email or phone. You can always arrange a 'one-off' trial session and take it from there.
