### **EVENTS**:

Our members are sent regular emails about events. Please ensure you opt in to receive these notifications. We hold the following events each year:

### Brisbane, Branches and Teacher Groups:

- Annual General Meeting: Brisbane (February) and regions; held at different dates and times, usually at the beginning of each year.
- ♦ Council/committee meetings: (February to December): it is not compulsory for members to attend meetings in Brisbane. If wish to be involved with your local Branch or Teacher Group, please contact them.

- Professional Development, workshops and masterclasses: Brisbane and regions regularly hold these throughout the year.
- ♦ Alan Lane Memorial Workshops: held in different regions biennually.
- Queensland Vocal Competition: End of May or early June (Brisbane). This
  is a national competition, open to singers of all ages residing in Australia.
- ♦ **Composers' Competition:** Gold Coast (May). Emerging composers of all ages are encouraged to enter their works of many and varied genres. The works are viewed or listened to live on the day of the competition (or via recording/video) with an audience present.
- Second-hand Music Sale: Brisbane (August).
- Queensland Piano Competition: Brisbane (September school holidays): held annually and open to pianists throughout Australasia.
- ♦ Charles & Motee Rogers Piano Competition: Toowoomba (around August).
- Cairns Branch bursaries:
  - Junior Bursary Open to music students in Year 7. Auditions are held in March.
  - Year 12 Bursary Open to Year 12 students who intend to continue their music studies the following year. Auditions are held in October/ November. The winner/s are also invited to perform at one of the Cairns Classical Music Group Concerts.
